Dayinsure Wales Rally GB Under 18s Policy

Dayinsure Wales Rally GB follows the MSA Under 18s Policy. It separates those who are under 16 and those over 16 as follows:

MSA Policy for Young Persons aged between their 16th and 18th birthdays at the date of the event:

2.1. Young person's aged between their 16th and 18th birthdays may perform the duties as a marshal commensurate with their grade designation and level of experience.

MSA Policy for Cadet Marshals (aged between their 11th and 16th birthdays at the date of the event):

3.1. Cadet Marshals must be appropriately supervised by a parent/guardian or temporary carer when they are in any area other than a formal spectator area or in an area to which spectators have access. Cadet Marshals are not to be located in trackside positions at any type of event.

The guide gives examples of what areas/roles are generally considered appropriate for Cadet Marshals to operate - actual duties which are considered appropriate will vary according to the nature, type and location of event.

Appropriate	Not Appropriate
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrival, service, re-group and main time controls • Start-line EXCLUDING countdown marshal • Stop line • Radio • Set-up and take down of stage or control ahead or following passage of competitive event 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start-line "countdown marshal" • Fire marshal • Flying finish (unless suitably protected) • In stage marshal (unless well clear of stage) • Spectator safety or control marshal

"All marshals that are under 18 years of age must be signed on using an under 18 signing-on form, which must be countersigned by the marshal's parent or guardian. Should an under 18 signing-on form not be available at signing-on, then the parent or guardian must sign next to their entry on the standard signing-on form."

Our signing on team from Rally Stage Team (RST) have the correct forms in place to comply with this policy.

Marshals' on-line accreditation

Please remember that from the beginning of 2016 **all NEW** marshals have been required to register with the MSA and complete the three on-line learning modules. Once these modules are complete, they will be classed as an accredited marshal. This applies to cadet marshals too. If you are thinking of bringing your son or daughter with you to the event, they **MUST** therefore have completed the on-line accreditation prior to attending. The link to this section is below.
